Introduction: The scheme of English essay and Paragraph Writing.

The scheme of English essay: Introduction, Body 1, Body 2, Body 3..., Conclusion.

Introduction:

The brief summary for your readers to get the overall information on your essay. To let them read the end of your essay, you need to capture their hearts to let them in your essay!

Body 1, 2, 3...:

You can describe what you want to say in 'Body parts.' The length of body and the essay must be complied with its requirements. Besides, you can use a lot of methods such as classification, contrasts and comparisons, cause and effect, and so forth.

Conclusion:

You can summarise your thesis point in this part. Please make sure to contain what you want to say the most to your readers in your essay.

Paragraph Writing:

In general, an English essay is written in the method of 'Paragraph Writing.' Let us consider what paragraph writing is!

A paragraph is a basic unit of essay which can consist of Introduction, Body, and Conclusion.

There is a topic sentence, which describes a main idea of the paragraph at the beginning, or the second of the paragraph.

A topic sentence must be a 'killer phrase' which is attractive for readers to keep their eyes on your essay! Otherwise, the readers may drop from your essays. The remaining parts of the paragraph are called 'supporting sentences' which support a topic sentence.
