A **compare-and-contrast** essay analyzes two subjects by comparing them, contrasting them, or both.

STRUCTURE

Introduction	The hook	A clear short and catchy sentence, which usually points out the importance of a topic.
	General statements	Give more general information on the topic
	Thesis	Write 2-3 similarities and differences in one sentence, generally.
Block 1 Paragraph 1	Topic sentence	Topic sentence (write about 2-3 points of similarities).
	Supporting details	Explain in detail. (Explain your point of view - how the 2 things are similar.)
Block 2 Paragraph 2	Topic sentence	Topic sentence (write about 2-3 points of differences).
	Supporting details	Explain in detail. (Explain - how the 2 things are different.)
Conclusion	There are 2 types of conclusions:	
	Restatement of thesis You can paraphrase your thesis (change some words or the structure of the sentence)	Short summary You can write short summary of main points in your body paragraph. To do so: rewrite your topic examples (paraphrase them).
